Our volunteer Farmers Market committee (Margaret Fields, Lorene Schramm, Heather Kerrigan, Terry Vanderwerff, and Al Scott) have made space for almost 30% new vendors and all of your old favorites. It will remain a "traditional" market, allowing only food items that you buy directly from the person who grew, baked, or made the item you are purchasing. We're also pleased to announce that Cook Memorial Library District will present "Stories at Farmers Market" each week. Be sure to bring the kids! Stay tuned for details.

You will be able to buy fresh-made fudge, freshly roasted and ground coffee, breads baked just hours ago, flower bouquets assembled before your eyes, exotic sauces and spine tingling salsas, warm kettlecorn, bottles of wine, crepes made just for you, hormone-free pork and beef, free-range chicken, caramel apples, organic vegetables, still-warm scones, mushrooms picked a few hours ago, the freshest of fruits, baguettes, a huge variety of cheeses (regular or artisan), scrumptious tarts, and even an organic chewy for your furry best friend. I'd better stop now...I can't type over the growling noises coming from my stomach!

Farmer's Market isn't the only thing sparkling and new this summer. Main Street Smokehouse, with the absolute best in perfectly smoked regional barbecue, will make their Out-To-Lunch debut this summer. How about Texas brisket flavored with tellicherry peppers and lemon, or baby back ribs with chipotle maple sauce? Mmmm.

It won't be easy to decide what's for lunch because our other new Out-To-Lunch additions, Sunset Foods and Egg Harbor, won't take a back seat to anyone when it comes to mouthwatering things to eat. And long-time favorite, Bauer's Party Masters, will lead our 10 other returnees like Mickey Finn's Brewery, Chip's Sub Depot, and Tacos El Rey De Oro to Cook Park. And the live music that MainStreet volunteers Peter Brush and Tom Bauer are working hard to line up for you is expected to be better than ever! Area favorites including The Usuals and Kevin Spika are back, along with eight other exceptional performers.

And talk about sparkling: our Car Fun on 21 vintage automobile shows will run from May through September this year. Celebrate American's love of the automobile when 100 or so perfectly restored cars over 25 years old are lovingly displayed on Church Street on the third Wednesday of each month. Something new: if Car Fun is rained out, we will automatically have the show the following Wednesday so you won't miss a day!

June brings the MainStreet Golf Outing, known among aficionados as the "most fun" outing in the Chicago metro area. Last year's record number of players will tell you that the string games, contests, and crazy sponsored holes make this one not to miss! It is 18 holes of golf, a golf cart, box lunch, hors d'oeuvres and cocktail hour (thanks Mickey Finn's!), your favorite beverage on the course (thanks Libertyville Bank & Trust and Harris Bank, Libertyville!) and cookout dinner (thanks Café Pyrenees!) for only \$99. We will even throw in a day away from the office at no charge, as prescribed by Dr. MainStreet!

The Village Orchestra will perform under new Director Dustin Helvie at Supper in the Park in Cook Park on Thursday evenings, and in Butler Park for the Village's 4th of July fireworks spectacular. We look forward to this all year!

LETTER FROM THE CHAIRMAN

I am so involved with MainStreet Libertyville that I am sometimes surprised to hear that every resident isn't familiar with our organization. I forget about new residents and others that haven't been around for the 20 years of our existence. That's right...we are celebrating our 20th anniversary this year!

MainStreet is part of the National Trust for Historic Preservation, founded in the 1970s to help small town downtowns compete with the new shopping centers that were popping up around America during that time.

The Village of Libertyville helped fund us in the early years and beyond and partnered with MainStreet to rebuild our then floundering shopping district. Many of you don't remember the boarded up stores, the 30% vacancy rate, and the deteriorating buildings. MainStreet used some of those funds to buy down loan rates with local participating banks, enabling our building owners to rehabilitate their historic buildings. We partnered with the Historical Society to do research on historic buildings and passed that information on to building owners who used it to make their building façades look just like they did at the turn of the century.

It gives me goosebumps to look at those old pictures of downtown Libertyville, with horses tied up in front of a building that I instantly recognize today! We continue to have a remarkably dedicated group of long-term building owners who are not only good business people, but who are truly interested in the well being of Libertyville and our downtown. The Village/property owner/MainStreet partnership has transformed our shopping district into the picture-perfect downtown we know today...and has raised your property values along the way as supply and demand made Libertyville a much desired place to live, work and play.

In addition to helping with historic preservation, MainStreet Libertyville also produces 18 community events a year, encouraging people to visit and enjoy our downtown more than ever. PumpkinFest, Trick or Treat on Main Street, Farmer's Market, Out-To-Lunch, Dickens of a Holiday, the Twilight Shuffle, and many more events have become part of many family traditions in Libertyville.

As the tax base has receded, our funding has turned to a residential membership base, dependent upon private donations to continue operating. Until recently, people often thought we were part of the Village...an organization people paid for with their taxes. We actually are a volunteer-based, certified 501(c)(3) not-for-profit that is dependent upon people just like you for support each year. We have 1.5 paid employees and over 1,500 remarkable volunteers that help us make Libertyville a very special place.

We thank you if you are a current member, and ask you to consider moving up a notch on our membership ladder. If you are not a member, please join at a membership level that is comfortable for you. We even have an option that bills your credit card a specified amount each month, making budgeting as easy as checking the box that fits your budget. Thanks for making MainStreet possible!

EAT, DRINK, AND BE MERRY IN DOWNTOWN LIBERTYVILLE

According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Americans of today eat in restaurants 33% more than just 10 years ago, almost one out of every five meals.

With the quality and diversity of restaurants in downtown Libertyville, we find it surprising that our residents have been able to limit themselves to just 1 meal in 5! We will soon have 22 restaurants in our downtown district!

We love our stand-bys like Townee Square, where Meg, Jane, Audrey, and Mel know everyone who walks in the door by first name and know what you want to order before you do. The Tavern keeps reinventing itself. It's about to move the lounge to the first floor and serve 'small plates' with fine wines and martinis. No wonder it has stayed at the top of our favorites list for over 26 years! Henry Yee's has completely updated their wonderfully varied Chinese menu, freshened up the seating area, and is again a top destination for the one out of five meal crowd.

Mickey Finn's Brewery's famous Mickey Burger became even more famous when it was named 'Best Burger' on the North Shore by Sun Times Media Group. Downtown Libertyville doesn't make it easy for a sandwich aficionado. How can you possibly decide between Chip's Sub Depot, the Picnic Basket, or Morgan's?

Maybe you avoid the decision by sharing some spicy chicken wings with blue cheese sauce at the Firkin, washed down with a Pinkeus Organic Heffe Weisse beer. And speaking of organic, there is no better spot at the bar than at Murphy's Health Food and Juice Bar. We recommend the 'Save the Chicken' sandwich for lunch, and for dinner, take home some fresh caught Alaskan salmon, which has a much fuller and richer taste than farm-raised.

And we dare you to try to pick your favorite item off Grandma's menu at all-time family favorite Trattoria Pomigliano.

It's impossible to choose a dish there! Or maybe you feel like steak today. 545 North Bar & Grill uses the same supplier as Ruth's Chris Steakhouse, offering you a mouthwatering, juicy, perfectly prepared steak in your own town at half the price.

It's been quite a walk, and we haven't even mentioned the luscious treats at Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory. Or have Charley surprise you at Parkview Gourmet with the perfectly chosen wine at exactly the price you wanted to pay. You can even create your own wine at Vintner's Cellar Winery, right after the neighborhood tasting party you organized.

Much anticipated area favorite Egg Harbor Café has opened in downtown Libertyville, and you probably already have discovered that it is even better than you thought it could be.

Main Street Smokehouse is planning on an April opening, with regional barbeque specialties smoked to perfection on owner Eddie Moore's 'best in the industry' Southern Pride smoker. Also just around the corner is Tommy's Pizza & Sports Bar, and then comes Waukegan icon Casa Bonita Mexican restaurant.

Here's a surprise: the Village has received permit applications for a new project on the former Dodge dealership property that will take its architectural guidance from our picture-perfect downtown. A "brick façade, built to the sidewalk, with parking behind" development will contain a Chipotle Mexican Grill and a Five Guys Burgers, called the "Willie Wonkas of burgercraft" by the Washington Post. Oh, no! Using available sides, you can make a possible 250,000 combinations!

Oh, decisions, decisions, decisions! We at MainStreet have decided to take it to the next level. We are going for three out of five meals out without leaving Libertyville.

MainStreet Libertyville is hosting our 6th annual self-guided Historic Walking Tour on Saturday, May 16 from 10am to 2pm beginning in Cook Park. Come and enjoy seeing an interesting mix of eclectic Tudor homes that have been built in Libertyville since this building style became popular in the 1920s and 30s.

These lovely homes with their distinctive design include various features that identify them as Tudor, such as steeply pitched roofs with prominent cross gables, arched doors, tall, narrow windows, and massive chimneys, which are commonly crowned by decorative chimney pots. Many feature decorative half-timbering on the second story.

The early Tudor style was seen in English late medieval palaces and simple folk homes of that era. Over time, the decorative detailing has been drawn from the Renaissance or modern Craftsman traditions. These features will catch your eye when driving or walking through our older neighborhoods. The charm of the Tudor home style has lasted through the ages as it has been altered to fit changing lifestyles.

Main Street Libertyville volunteers will be in Cook Park distributing the walking tour booklets with photos, history, and directions to the various properties. The tour booklets are offered for a donation of \$5.00 to MainStreet Libertyville. Come by on Saturday, May 16, and purchase a booklet. Even if you can't do the tour, the booklet provides a history of our town of yesteryear and today with tidbits of Libertyville "lore" that you will enjoy.

This is a walking, biking, or driving tour of the facades of these homes, and possibly a couple of interiors, which the Design Committee is currently pursuing.
